ID Mail Systems Adds Media Mail Capability to Its Manifesting Software Suite

Middletown, CT (July 24, 2006) – ID Mail Systems, Inc. announced today the release of Media Mail processing capability as part of its manifesting software suite. This latest release allows users to submit both flat and machinable parcel Media items for participation in USPS worksharing discounts. Like previous released classes, the Media Mail module creates a USPS compliant manifest as well as the appropriate postage statement and customer billing report. Delivery Confirmation is also supported for use with Media parcels.

The addition of Media Mail increases the number of supported classes to five, including the previously released First, Standard, Priority and Bound Printed Matter. The software suite enhances customer service with Delivery Confirmation to ensure an item is received by the intended recipient. Delivery Confirmation is supported for Media and Bound Printed Matter parcels as well as for all Priority Mail items. The use of ID Mail's manifesting suite allows mailers to process a wide variety of mail classes, including mixed-weight items within a class. With its ability to apply a permit imprint on each item, the software eliminates the labor and ink expense of metering.

The manifesting suite is supported by both the ID Mail Dispatcher for automated processing of flats and the MAX-M for manual processing of both flats and parcels. The Dispatcher mixed-mail system automatically feeds, images, codes, prints and sorts items for USPS, international, incoming and private courier mail. The combination of the manifesting suite with the tabletop MAX-M system allows a processor to expand service into parcels and provides a low-cost solution for smaller volumes of both flats and parcels.

"With the release of Media Mail, we continue to strengthen our manifesting suite by including the classes most utilized by the mailing industry," offered Jerry Fenerty, President of ID Mail. Mr. Fenerty continued, "We're pleased with the industry's reception of our manifesting product and believe this latest enhancement will continue our penetration of the market. As we look ahead to the 2007 Rate Case and increased discounts for First and Standard Class flats, manifesting of mixed-weight items will become even more appealing to mailers as a way to enhance their revenue and cut expenses."
